



AUDITION VIDEO TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Busking with Talent ("BWT" or "the Program") is a global focus Entertainment Competition Series and Weekly Buskers' Performances featuring Contestants of singers, dancers, magicians, comedians, and free-style performers of eighteen (18) years or older competing to win grand prizes. The Contestant (s) by participating in this online audition video ("Audition Video") for consideration of good will by Jireh Entertainment Production ("Producer") in connection with the BWT's Program, (as defined below) acknowledges that she/he has read, understand and voluntarily agree to abide by these Online Audition Video Terms and Conditions Agreement in its entirety.

The contestant (s) (as defined below) of the BWT's Reality Series Competition, acknowledges that the "Effective Date" of these Terms and Conditions shall be the date on which the Contestant(s) submits its Audition Video, prior to submitting an online Audition Video, the contestant affirms that as a Registered Contestant that each contestant member meets the Eligibility Requirements in Section A below. In addition, that the Contestant meets the Audition Video Submission Requirements in Section B below.

Audition Videos will stop being accepted thirty days after the submission date started in the sole discretion of Producer. No Audition Video will be accepted after 11:59 p.m.PST on the close of the Video Submission Period.

Producer makes no guarantee that all online audition videos received will be viewed, unless otherwise, the contestant(s) have chosen the submission criteria in Section 2 (f).

As used herein, "Contestant(s) and or Registered Applicant will refer to the applicant(s) who completes the data fields on the Audition Video Registration form and uploads the Audition Video on our website platform powered by eTribez.com. Contestant applicant(s) must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.

1. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

(a) The Contestant must be able to prove at the time of the registration and audition that all contestants of a performance meet the following requirements:

- (i) Be a United States citizen;
- (ii) Proof of age (if necessary)
- (iii) Be a legal permanent resident(s) of the State in which the contestant is the State's Applicant;
- (iv) Possess a current employment authorization (EAD) card (work permit) or unrestricted authorization;
- (v) Be in the United States legally at the time of the initial audition. All contestants will be required to show proof of unrestricted employment authorization or have appropriate visa status in the United States that allows them to compete prior to starting the competition.

(b) Contestant of a "Performance" may include: 1) a contestant who performs alone; or 2) multiple contestants who perform together as a group. Any contestant in a Performance that is under the age of eighteen (18) years old is NOT ALLOWED to submit any information but may participate in any Audition under the Video Submission & Criteria Process in section 3 (a) of this agreement.

(c) Producer and /or a designated Broadcast network reserves the right to remove from the Reality Program any person including any contestant(s) of the Performance that may create the appearance of impropriety. Such decision may be determine by Producer's and/or designated broadcast network's sole discretion, is sufficiently connected with the Competition Program but not limited to the Producer, and may include affiliated companies, or any of their respective licensees, successors or assigns; or any other person or entity connected with the production, administration or judging of the auditions or the Program; any television station or channel, cable network, or satellite network that may air or

otherwise exhibit the Program or any variation thereof; any person or entity involved in the development, production, distribution, or other exploitation of the Program or any variation thereof; any sponsor of the Program (including, but not limited to any corporation or its advertising agency; or any person or entity supplying services or prizes to the Program, such that such person's participation in the Program could create the appearance of unfair advantage. Conversely, Producer and/or designated broadcast networks reserves the right to allow any person to remain part of the Program who may have a connection with the Program or any of the Producer Entities if, in Producer's and/or designated broadcast networks sole discretion, Producer and/or designate broadcast networks determines that such person's involvement in the Program does not and will not affect the integrity of the Program.

2. AUDITION VIDEO SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

I. General Requirements:

(a) The contestant may submit ONLY ONE (1) Audition Video.

(b) Contestant(s) who wish to be eligible for State Grand prizes must be available to perform in the BWT's National Competition. JIREH Entertainment Production and its affiliated, the Program, BUSKING WITH TALENT (BWT) does not make any exception to this requirement.

(c) Audition Videos should be submitted at www.bwtauditions.com by clicking ("Register"). Follow the on-screen prompts to register and upload your Audition Video. The Audition Video will NOT be accepted after 11:59 p.m. (PST) on the close of the Video Submission Period. Any video submitted shall be the sole property of JIREH ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTION and its affiliated Program, Busking with Talent (BWT) nor shall I receive any compensation in connection with use of these statements, photographs, and/or audio or video recordings for promotional, commercial, or other purposes

(d) Only one contestant in a Performance (regardless of the number of contestants) must sign up as the Registered Contestant on the Website and must have internet access during BWT's Program Season.

(e) General Submission of Audition videos are accepted on a 'First Come First Served' basis. While every audition submission is especially important to BWT, due to the thousands of audition submissions we are expected to receive, we only have a limited number of available contestant spots for BWT's Competitions. Therefore, we cannot guarantee all videos will be viewed or screened.

(f) Advance Submission of Audition Videos. The contestant(s) may choose to pay an introductory submission fee prior to registration for any one of the competitions. The payment of such fee is to ensure that your audition video is in line as a priority for guaranteed submission review, otherwise, your registration is on a "First Come First Served basis" as they are received. The introductory submission fee does not guarantee that you will be selected, nor does it guarantee that you will obtain a spot in the competition. Whether or not you are selected for the competition is strictly up to the efforts and talent of your audition video that you submit.

(g) The Audition Video must be entered by a registered contestant at BWT's Audition Website:www.bwtauditions.com who is at least eighteen (18) years old, a legal resident of the State in which the contestant is registering to compete and who has the authority to act on behalf of the other contestants of a group in the competition.

(h) Contestant(s) involved in more than one performance per season will be disqualified from taking part in any other Competition of BWT. Any contestant who is part of a group, regardless if they are not a registered contestant, can only compete in one's state at a time of BWT's Competition Season.

(i) The Contestant's Audition Video must comply with all requirements. Any Audition Video that, in Producer's discretion, does not comply with the requirements may be disqualified and may be denied.

(j) The Contestant's Audition Video submission will not be complete until the Registered Contestant have accepted these Terms and Conditions, all additional agreements, and the registration in its entirety.

(k) Producer reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, the eligibility of each Contestant's Audition Video. The ELIGIBLE CONTESTANT(S) MUST SUBMIT THE AUDITION VIDEO IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS outline in this agreement.

(l) Producer reserves the right in its sole discretion to modify or change the eligibility requirements or submission requirements hereunder from time to time and such modifications will be effective upon posting the 'changes and modifications' to the Audition Video's Website.

II. Audition Video Content:

(a) Audition Video Content must be originally submitted and cannot be a link to any social media network platform.

(b) Audition Video must conform to the requirements of these Terms and Conditions, as well as the BWT's Auditions Privacy Policy, and its Content and Release Agreement. The Terms and Conditions, Privacy Policy and Content Release Agreement may be amended from time to time.

(c) Audition Video should not exceed four (4) minutes including an introduction. The Contestant(s) may include a short introduction (no more than thirty (30) seconds) stating the name of the Performance, age(s) of participants, Contestant's location, and any other information the Contestant would like to convey within the time frame of the audition.

(d) Prohibited Audition Video from contestant(s) must NOT contain material which is sexually explicit, obscene, pornographic, violent (for example, relating to murder, weapons, cruelty, abuse, etc.), discriminatory (based on race, sex, religion, national origin, physical disability, sexual orientation or age), illegal (for example, underage drinking, substance abuse, computer hacking, etc.), offensive, threatening, profane or harassing. Any such contestant(s) will be banned from all present and future competitions.

3. VIDEO SUBMISSION & CRITERIA PROCESS:

(a) Judging. Audition Videos submitted for consideration online will be judged according to the same parameters as other auditions for the Reality Program. If the Contestant is selected to advance to the next round of the competition, the participant(s) may be required to provide or arrange for the Contestant (s) own travel as necessary, which will be at a location selected by Producer in its sole discretion. No member(s) of the Contestant under eighteen (18) years of age can audition unless otherwise, there has been history of performing with the group and the under-age has a release of the parent and/or guardian and a release from the other contestants.

(b) Further Documentation. In the event Producer chooses the Contestant(s) to participate in the State Competition and/or its Weekly Buskers' Performances' Video Streaming Program, the Contestant(s) of the Performance will be required by the Producer to fill out, provide a certify signature of these terms and conditions and other additional forms, including, without limitation, a Contestant Agreement and Release and Confidentiality Agreement. All Judges decisions are final, and no correspondence will be forthcoming.

The CONTESTANT MUST BE A RESIDENT IN THE STATE OF THE STATE'S COMPETITION. In addition, the Contestant may be required to complete an extensive background questionnaire and will be subject to a thorough background investigation and other examinations, at Producer's discretion.

If Producer chooses the Contestant to continue to the next round of the competition, the Contestant will be required to sign a performance and talent management contract, a commercial advertisement contract, and/or merchandising contract at Producer's sole and absolute discretion. The Contestant's family and/or guests should be prepared to sign releases concerning the possible taping and/or recording of their name, likeness, voice, conversation, etc.

ALL FORMS MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND TRUTHFULLY. IF THE CONTESTANT FAILS TO COMPLETE ANY FORM, GIVE FALSE INFORMATION, OR FAIL TO REVEAL ANY PERTINENT INFORMATION AS REQUIRED, THE CONTESTANT MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE COMPETITION PROCESS.

(c) Disqualifications. Producer reserves the right to disqualify and/or exclude, in its sole and absolute discretion, any individual(s) from the audition process for any reason or for no reason at all, including without limitation, violation of any portion of these Terms and Conditions, or tampering with the entry process or the audition process. Producer also reserves the right to change these Terms and Conditions at any time, with or without notice. Being chosen to audition and/or compete at any level in the process does NOT ensure that the Contestant(s) will be selected to continue to the next stage of the competition process.

(d) License. The Contestant(s) shall retain all ownership rights in the Contestant's Audition Video. By submitting the Audition Video, the Contestant hereby grant to Producer, in perpetuity, a non-exclusive, royalty-free, and freely transferable license to use, reproduce, distribute, prepare derivative works of, display, adapt, reformat, translate, and otherwise exploit and perform all or any portion of the Audition Video for any purpose whatsoever, including, without limitation, in connection with (i) the BWT's Program, including, without limitation, advertising, marketing, promotion, merchandising and the exploitation of any and all ancillary and subsidiary rights, and redistributing part or all of the Program (and derivative works thereof), and (ii) the business of Producer and/or designated broadcast networks and Producer and/or designated broadcast network of Internet websites, applications, video streaming television, video on demand and any other media or technology (including, without limitation, Internet protocol, wireless or digital platforms or interfaces) through which Producer and/or designated broadcast networks may distribute content to end Contestants, whether now existing or hereafter developed (together, the "Platforms"), in any and all media formats and through any and all media distribution and advertising and promotional purposes, without accounting, notification, credit or other obligation to the Contestant. For the avoidance of doubt, without limiting the generality of the rights granted to Producer and/or any Producer Entity, these rights include, without limitation, the absolute right to edit and/or alter any Audition Video distribute and synchronize all or any portion of the Contestant's Audition Video in timed relation to any other visual elements; to web cast, pod cast, iTunes, re-publish, re-broadcast, re-platform, port, syndicate, route, and link to and from all or any portion of the Contestant(s) Audition Video; to encrypt, encode and decode, and compress and decompress all or any portion of the Contestant's Audition Video; to edit, mix, combine, merge, distort, superimpose, create or add special effects, illusions and/or other material to or of all or any portion of the Contestant's Audition Video; to create composite, unusual photographs, videos, animations, stunt, comic, motion pictures and/or voice reproductions from all or a portion of the Contestant's Audition Video; and to excerpt and/or abstract portions of the Contestant's Audition Video in order to host, store, index, categorize and display the Contestant's Audition Video on or through the Platforms. Producer has no obligation to review the Audition Video or to use it any manner whatsoever.

4. CONTESTANTS' PERFORMANCES AND CONDITIONS:

(a) All contestant and/or contestants will receive an assigned registration ID number for BWT's Competition Program.

(b) Contestants may submit only one audition video performance per episode of the BWT's Program.

(c) Any contestant, who has auditioned at any-one of BWT's selected Competition's state locations, may not re-audition at any other state locations in the current BWT's Program Reality Season.

(d) If the number of contestants seeking to audition are excessive, the Producer reserves the right to limit the number of contestants at any audition location. Once a limit has been met a backlog for each state may be kept for the next BWT's season and the contestant may be invited to registered for the new season competition.

(e) All performances must be done in good taste: no music or lyrics that considers to be offensive may be performed. The Producer reserve the right to exclude any performances that may be deemed offensive or unsuitable to a general audience.

(f) Acceptable documentation to prove ownership of your music may be required in the form of either a certificate of copyright, proof of song registration with BMI, ASCAP, etc., or a notarized copy of the application for the copyright with a signed statement by the contestant as to its status.

(g) The contestant and members of a group thereof is/are not eligible to participate if you have previously been a winner of Busking with Talent's State and National Competition.

(h) The contestants are selected and screened by members of respective state focus groups and state host producers. The chosen contestants who have made the cut are critiqued by State's Contestant Judges for the selection of the top ten contestants to compete in the Busking with Talent's State Competition.

(i) The contestants are subject to the state's voting bloc of the respective state's residents/viewers only. All State's Contestants Judges may exercise their vote to save one contestant from the state's residents voting bloc or one state's contestants judge may use a "WILD CARD" without the voting of the other judges to expedite a contestant to the next round of the competition. The viewers statewide will cast their vote for their favorite contestant. The remaining contestants with the most votes will move to the next round of the competition. The contestants with the two lowest score will be eliminated from BWT's State Competition.

(j) The winner of each BWT's State Competition will advance to the National Competition. The National Contestants Judges will vote on one contestant to move to the next round of the competition, and to be saved from the national voting bloc or one judge may use a "WILD CARD" without the voting of the other judges to expedite a contestant to the next round of the competition. The viewers nationwide will cast their vote for their favorite contestant. The remaining contestants with the most votes will move to the next round of the competition. The contestant with the lowest score will be eliminated from the BWT's National's Competition.

(k) The Weekly Buskers' Performances will be selected and screened by selective members of a focus group and host producers. The Buskers may perform for weekly prizes and contributions. The Buskers who are competing for a chance to perform for contributions will be selected from a pool of applicants each week on a "First Come First Served" basis. Weekly Buskers' Performances contributions as such will be advertised and marketing nationwide. It is the sole discretion of the viewers and fans whether they will contribute to you as a performer, just as they would do on the street or in a square. BWT makes no guarantee that any performance will receive any amount in contributions. However, contestants can opt-in and be invited to be a contestant in our prize pool for the chance to win one of three prizes. (Section 4 (m) below)

(l) The performers may select to pay an introductory submission fee prior to registration. The introductory fee is to ensure that your audition video is in line as a priority for guarantee submission review, otherwise, your registration is on a "First Come First Served" basis as they are received. The introductory submission fee does not guarantee that you will be selected, nor does it guarantee that you will obtain a spot in the competition. Whether or not you are selected for the competition is strictly up to your efforts and talent of your audition video that you submit.

(m) BWT's Weekly Buskers' Performances will include a lottery pool to invite selected contestants to participate on one or more of its channel's programs. The performers will have a chance to showcase their talent before a combined audience of 168 million viewers which include four digital channel networks currently. These are highly regarded spots, and every contestant must bring their "A" game to be chosen for this opportunity. The winners' prizes will consist of a Top Prize, Second Prize, and Third Prize. The Prize amounts may vary each week and will be announced prior to each week's competition.

(n) BWT in its sole discretion may add a WILD CARD contestant to its Competitions. This WILD CARD may be introduced prior to the start-up of any competition as an alternative and/or to give each contestant an extra bonus to compete.

(o) Representations and Warranties / Indemnification. The Contestant represent and warrant as follows: (i) the Audition Video is the copyright owner, or has the necessary authorization to submit the Audition Video hereunder, (ii) the performance in the Audition Video is the Contestant's original performance; (iii) the Audition Video is wholly original with the Participant and as of the date of submission, and is not the subject of any existent or threatened litigation or claim; (iv) the Audition Video neither infringes upon nor violates the intellectual property rights or other rights of any other person or entity; (v) the Audition Video does not and will not violate any applicable laws, and meets the Audition Video Submission Requirements set forth in Section B above.

The Contestant will upon request, furnish to Producer any documentation, substantiation, and releases necessary and reasonably required for all copyrighted material, music, identifiable third parties, identifiable locations, and releases from anyone who assisted in the creation of the Audition Video to prove, confirm, verify, and substantiate participant's compliance with any or all these Terms and Conditions, including, without limitation, the foregoing representations, and warranties. In the event the Contestant cannot provide all required releases, Producer reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to discard or remove the Contestant's Audition Video, or seek to secure the releases and clearances for the benefit of Producer and/or the Producer Entities or may allow the applicable Audition Video to be utilized. Additionally, the Contestant represent and warrant that the Performance will not acquire any trademark rights, copyrights, or any other rights in the trademarks, trade names, logos or other intellectual property of Producer or any other Producer Entity. Each Producer Entity specifically reserves its respective right to protect its intellectual property against any infringement or other illegal or improper use. The Contestant agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Producer Entities, and all its affiliates from and against any and all third-party claims, actions or proceedings of any kind and from any and all damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses relating to or arising out of any breach or alleged breach of any of the warranties, representations, or agreements of the Contestant hereunder.

(p) Conditions of Contestant(s) This online Audition Video may be subjected to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and is the sole responsibility and obligation of the contestant(s). The Contestant(s) hereby: (a) agrees that Producer and its affiliates Entities shall have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless by the Contestant(s) against any liability for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind to person(s) (including death) or property resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, as a result of participating in this online Audition Video or any related activity to JIREH ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTION, and the Program of Busking with Talent (BWT); (b) release the Producer and its affiliated Entities and their respective advertising and promotion partners, fulfillment and/or State's Focus Group Participants, State Contestants Judges, National Contestants Judges and their affiliated agencies, retailers, franchises, agents and their estate and/or family members from all liability, claims, action, or proceedings relating to this Audition Video and from injuries or damages arising in connection with or relating to contestant and contestants' participation in this Audition Video; and (c) waive any right to claim ambiguity in the Audition Video or these Terms and Conditions. Producer and designated broadcast networks reserve the right to modify these Terms and Conditions, remove suspect Audition Videos, and/or cancel, terminate or suspend any portion of the online Audition Video at any time and for any reason (or no reason at all) in their absolute discretion. Producer reserves the right to disqualify and/or exclude, in its sole and absolute discretion, any individual from any of the auditions video for any reason or for no reason at all, including without limitation, violation of any portion of BWT's Program rules, violation of any of these Terms and Conditions, or tampering with the entry process or the audition process. Producer also reserves the right to change BWT's Program rules and procedures at any time. Being chosen to audition and/or compete at any level in the competition does NOT ensure that the Contestant will be selected to advance to the next stage of the competition process.

(q) Privacy Policy. Any personal information supplied by the Contestant submission of the online audition video. Producer or designated broadcast network will be subject to the privacy policy posted at www.bwtauditions.com participating in the Audition Video, the Contestant(s) grants the Producer Entities permission to share the Contestant's email address and any other personally identifiable information with the other Producer and its affiliated Entities for the purpose of this online Audition and/or the production of the Busking with Talent's Reality Program and any related use of statements, photographs, and/or audio or video recordings for promotional, commercial, or other purposes that may derived out of the production of the Program, BUSKING WITH TALENT, (BWT), nor shall the contestant or contestants receive any compensation in connection with such activities.

(r) Nature of Relationship / Waiver of Equitable Relief. The Contestant(s) understand and acknowledge that the Producer and its Affiliates, Subsidiaries, and or Entities have wide access to ideas, stories, designs, and other literary materials, and that new ideas are constantly being submitted to them or being developed by their own respective teams. The Contestant acknowledge that many ideas may be competitive with, similar or identical to the Contestant's Audition Video and/or each other in theme, idea, format, or other respects. The Contestant acknowledges and agrees that the Contestant will not be entitled to any compensation because of the use by the Producer and its affiliated Entities of any such similar or identical material. The Contestant acknowledge and agree that the Producer Entities do not now and shall not have in the future any duty or liability, direct or indirect, vicarious, contributory, or otherwise, with respect to the infringement or protection of the copyright in and to the Audition Video. The Contestant acknowledge that, with respect to any claim by the Contestant(s) relating to or arising out of the actual or alleged exploitation or use of any Audition Video or other material

submitted in connection with the Audition Video via online by any Producing Entity, the damage, if any, thereby caused to the Contestant will not be irreparable or otherwise sufficient to entitle the Contestant to seek injunctive or other equitable relief or in any way to charge the production, distribution, exhibition or other exploitation of the Audition Video or BWT's Reality Program or any other production or allegedly based on the Audition Video, and the Contestant's rights and remedies in any such event shall be strictly bind by these terms and conditions of any right to recover damages, if any, in an action at law.

(s) Important: Please Read General Release and Limitations on Liability. By participating in this online Audition Video, the Contestant(s) agree that: (i) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of conflict arising out of or connected with the Audition Video, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of legal action; (ii) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to real out-of-pocket costs incurred written prior approval related expenses of the Producer Entity and or its affiliates' entities, but in no event will attorneys' fees be awarded or recoverable; and (iii) under no circumstances will the Contestant(s) be permitted to obtain any award for, and hereby knowingly and expressly waive all rights to seek, punitive, incidental or consequential damages and/or any other damages, and/or any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. The Contestant(s) acknowledge and agree that the Producer and its affiliated Entities, employees, production team but not limited to the focus group participants, state contestants judges, national contestants judges, their agencies, web masters/suppliers, contractors and vendors are not responsible for any costs, injuries, losses, or damages of any kind arising from or in connection with: (a) incomplete, lost, late, misdirected, or illegible submissions or for failure to receive submissions due to any cause, including without limitation human, transmission, or technical problems, failures, or malfunctions of any kind, whether originating with sender, with the Producer and its affiliated Entities or otherwise, that may limit a Contestant's ability to participate in this Audition Video via online; (b) incorrect or inaccurate information whether caused by Internet Contestants, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in connection with this online Audition Video and assume no responsibility for any error, omission, malfunction, interruption, deletion, defect, or delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft, or destruction or unauthorized access to, tampering, or hacking; (c) any injury or damage resulting from participation in the Audition Video via online (including, without limitation, claims, costs, injuries, losses and damages related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, or any claims, costs, injuries, losses, or damages related to or based on the contestant's rights of publicity or privacy); or (d) any claim by the Contestant for defamation or portrayal in a false light. Producer and its affiliated Entities assume no responsibility for any damage to the Contestant's computer system, which is occasioned by accessing the Audition Video's Website via online, or participating in this Audition Video via online, or for any computer system, phone line, hardware, software or program malfunctions, or other errors, failures, delayed computer transmissions or network connections that are human or technical in nature, or for the incorrect or inaccurate capture of information, or the failure to capture any information. Producer reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any participant that violates the Audition Video Submission Requirements, tampers with the Audition Video process or operation of the Audition Video via online or performances in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to threaten, abuse or harass any other person. If, for any reason, this Audition Video via online is not capable of operating as planned by reason of infection by computer virus, worms, bugs, tampering, hacking, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes which, in the sole opinion of Producer, corrupt or affect the administration, security, integrity or proper conduct of this Audition Video via online, Producer and designated broadcast networks reserve the right, at their absolute discretion, to close the Audition Video Submission Period at any time, cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this Audition Video via online or take any other action deemed fair and equitable by Producer and the Audition Video Process without any incurred damaged and/or liability on their parts thereof.

5. GOVERNANCE:

(a) Governing Law. All issues and questions concerning the validity, interpretation and enforceability of these terms and conditions, or the rights and obligations of contestant submitters in connection with the ONLINE AUDITION VIDEO or in connection with any audition or other material submitted in connection with the auditions via online, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Delaware.
